AVENUES OF SERVICE:

1. CLUB SERVICE

The projects done by the club for its own members are categorized as Club Service projects. This avenue promotes the development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service.

2. COMMUNITY SERVICE

The activities that are done to improve the quality of life in their community are termed as Community service projects. In a nutshell, they are projects done for the welfare of the society.

- Donating necessities to Old age homes or Orphanages

3. PROFESSIONAL SERVICE

Projects done to enhance the personal or professional skills of the members are termed under Professional service projects. The projects under this avenue usually develop knowledge over a certain topic. Some projects under Professional Service:

- Talent hunt competition in schools and colleges
- Implant training and Industrial visit

4. INTERNATIONAL SERVICE

Projects that are designated to meet humanitarian needs of people in many lands are termed as International service projects. The projects done on UN recognized international days or in coordination with a club of another district are all categorized under this avenue. Some projects under International Service:
