

ROTARY INTERNATIONAL DISTRICT 3201:

The Rotaract is an organization which was earlier a youth program of the Rotary International but now a membership organization by itself. The members of this organization are called Rotaractors. For easy governance purpose, the entire world in the Rotary front has been divided into various regions, zones, and further into districts. It is to be noted that the Rotary International Districts follows a unique pattern and doesn't necessarily coincide with the geographical districts. Each of the Rotary International Districts are allocated a unique individual number for the sole purpose of easy identification.

Having said that, we belong to the Rotary International District 3201. We belong the South Asian Region and come under Zone 5. The Rotary International District was bifurcated from the erstwhile Rotary International District 3200 during the Rotary Year 2008-2009. The district encompasses the geographical parts of Cochin, Coimbatore, Idukki, Palakkad and Trissur, of the southern peninsula of the Indian sub-continent. The district comes under Zone 5, South Asian region as per the Rotary International's division. The district has held 14 DRR's till date and currently there are _____ Rotary Clubs with _____ active Rotarians; _____ Rotaract Clubs with _____ active Rotaractors and _____ Interact clubs with _____ active Interactors.

The district's first DRR was PDRR Kishore Ranganath (at present a Rotarian from the Rotary Club of Cochin East).
